My name is Michele Geist; I live at "37 Clark Lane", Waltham.

I am writing to recognize the swift and professional response of the Waltham Fire Department, in general, and Rescue 6, (Captain Mike Innis, Firefighters Robert Davis and Frank Monaco), in particular.

On the afternoon of November 13<sup>th</sup>, I had been "rear-ended" on Main Street by two vehicles; one of the two having had a snow plow in neutral position. I had sustained trauma to my lower back. Within minutes of notification, the Department, along with police and paramedics, responded swiftly. While in the process of being prepared to be "ambulance'd", Firefighter Robert Davis, with great care/sensitivity, "assisted" me as, & with significant discomfort, attempted to be positioned on the gurney. As this was a "trying" time, it was only too clear - the power that "human" compassion.
